- ✓ A concessions stand will be available; breakfast burritos and Jamba Juice will be sold, as well as a variety of snack and drink items.

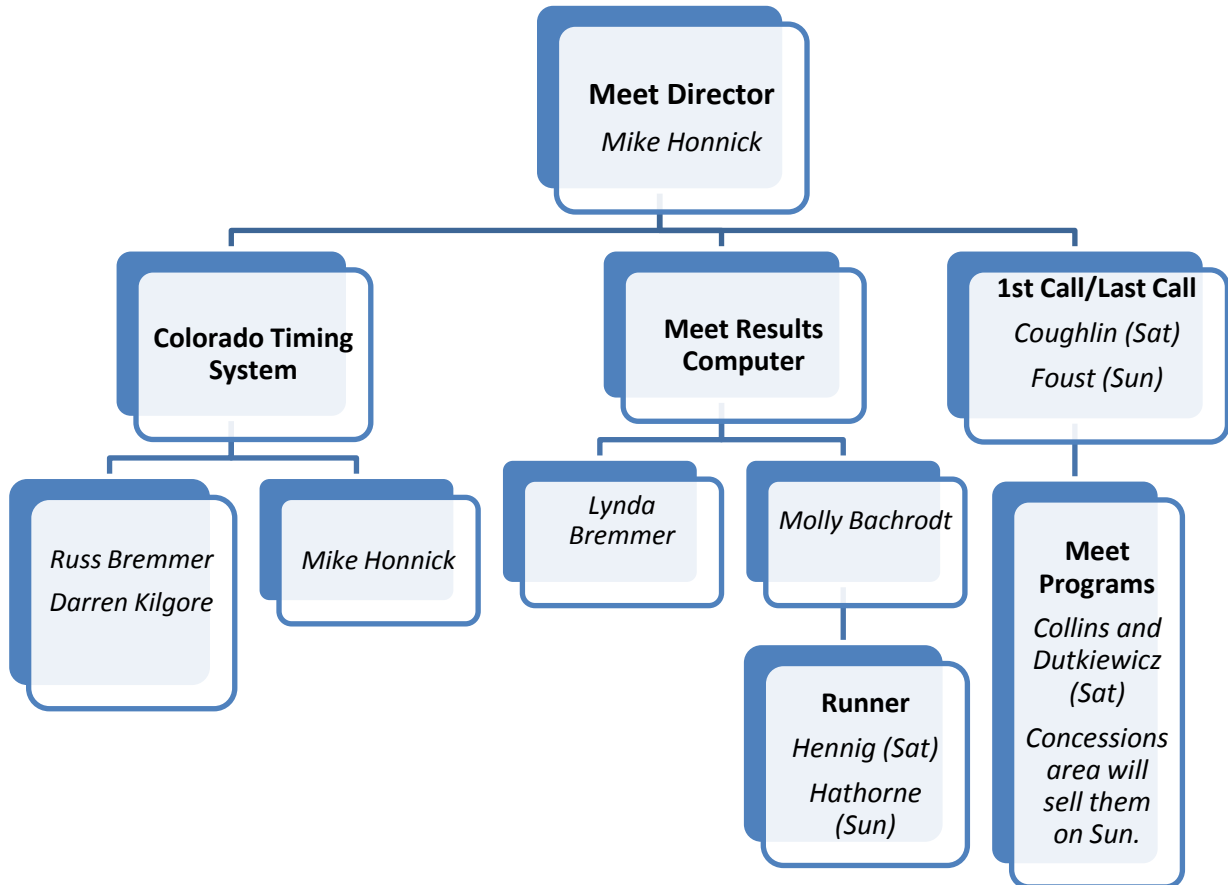
## **Volunteer Responsibilities**

### **Saturday and Sunday**

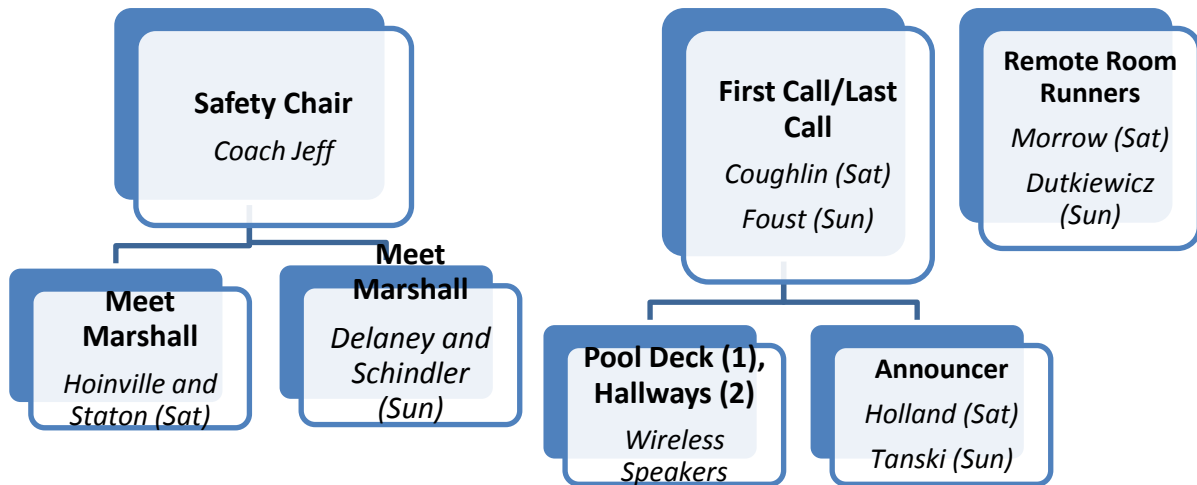
- ✓ SHOW UP to your job.

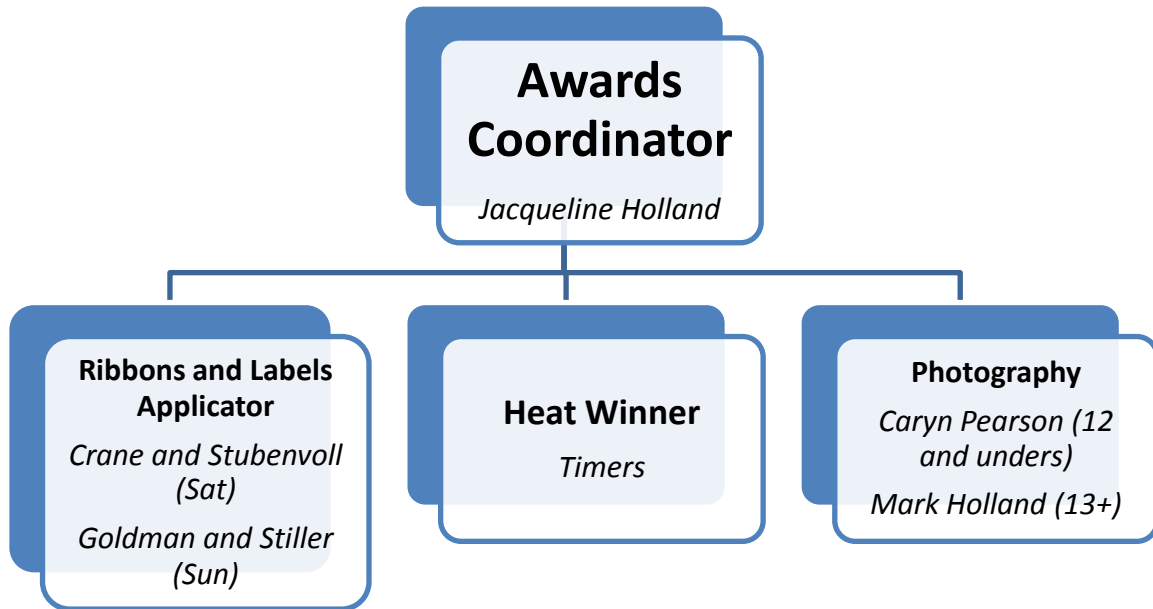

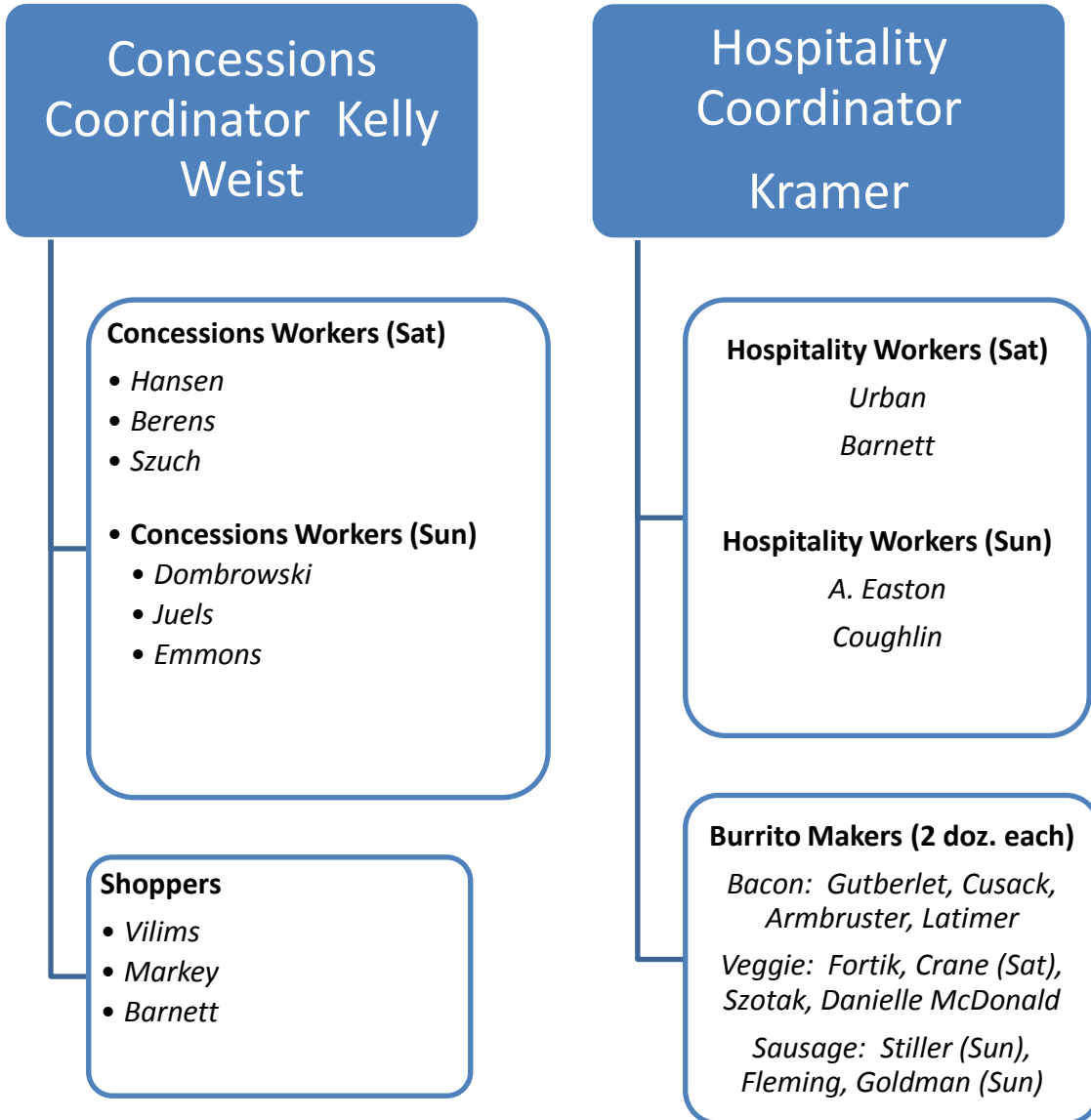

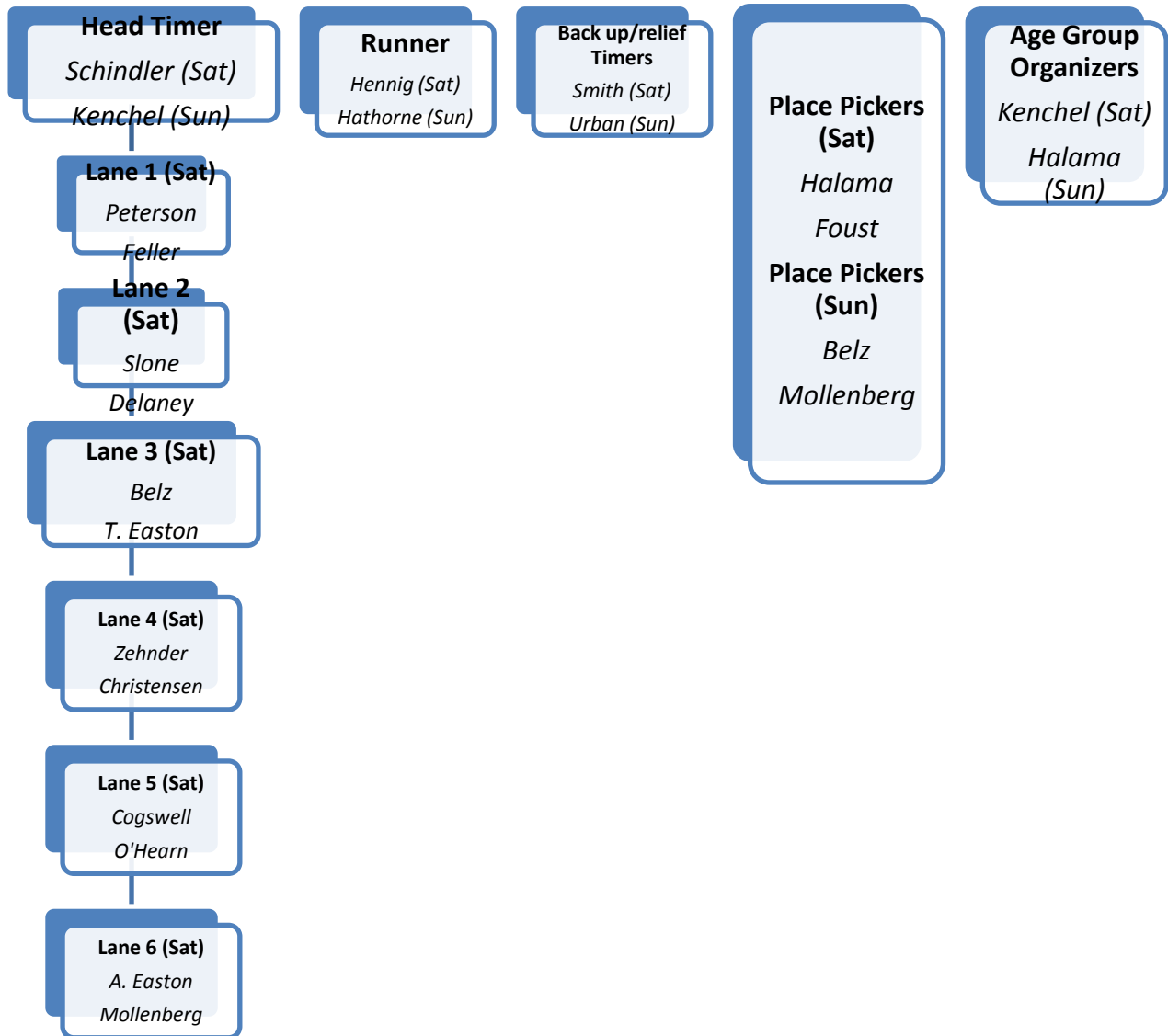

# Timing

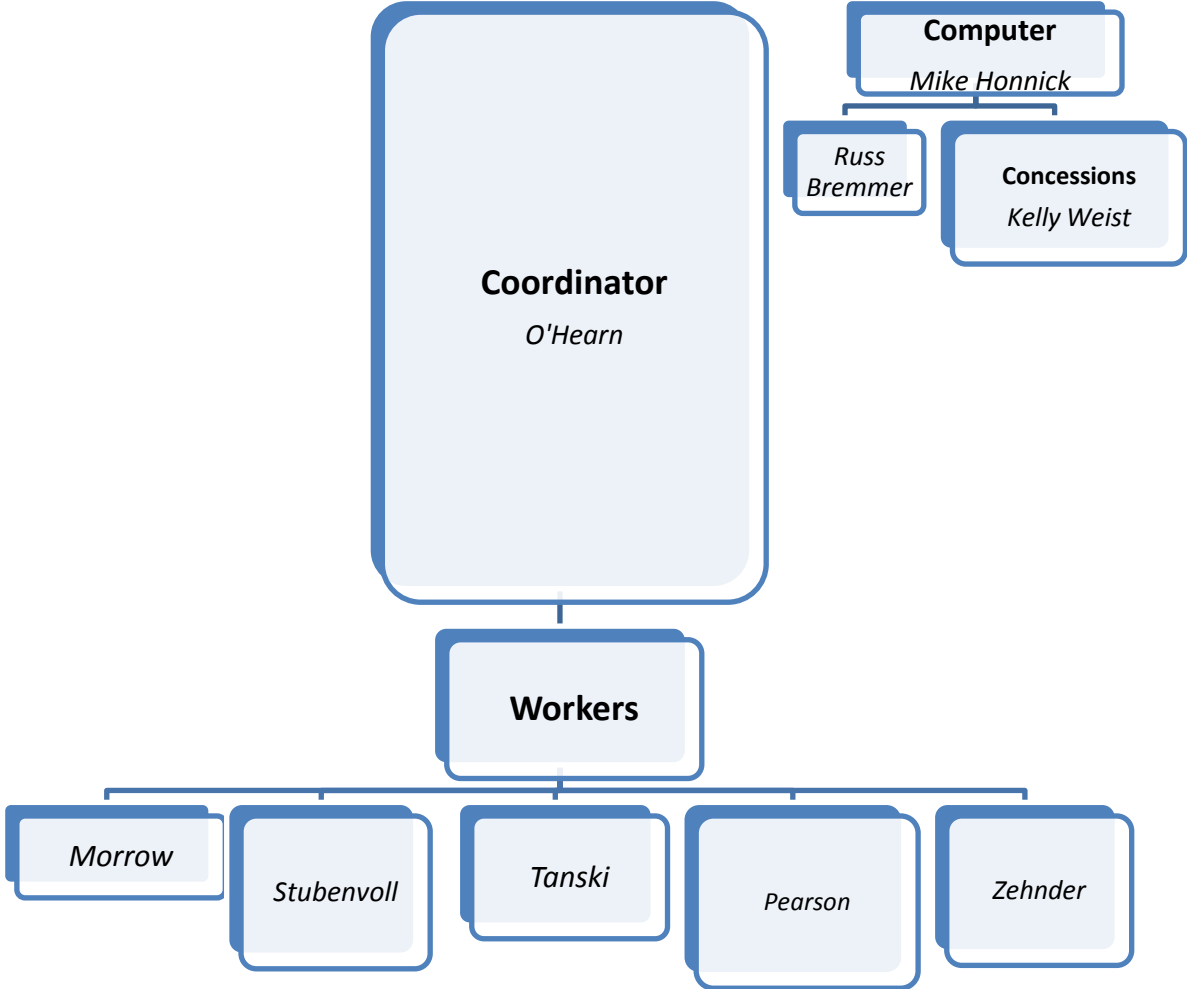
Extra timers, if needed, are: Hathorne (Sat), Emmons (Sat), Juels (Sat), Hoinville (Sun), and Purrington (Sun).

Everybody listed above **must check in** with the head timer to see if they are needed.

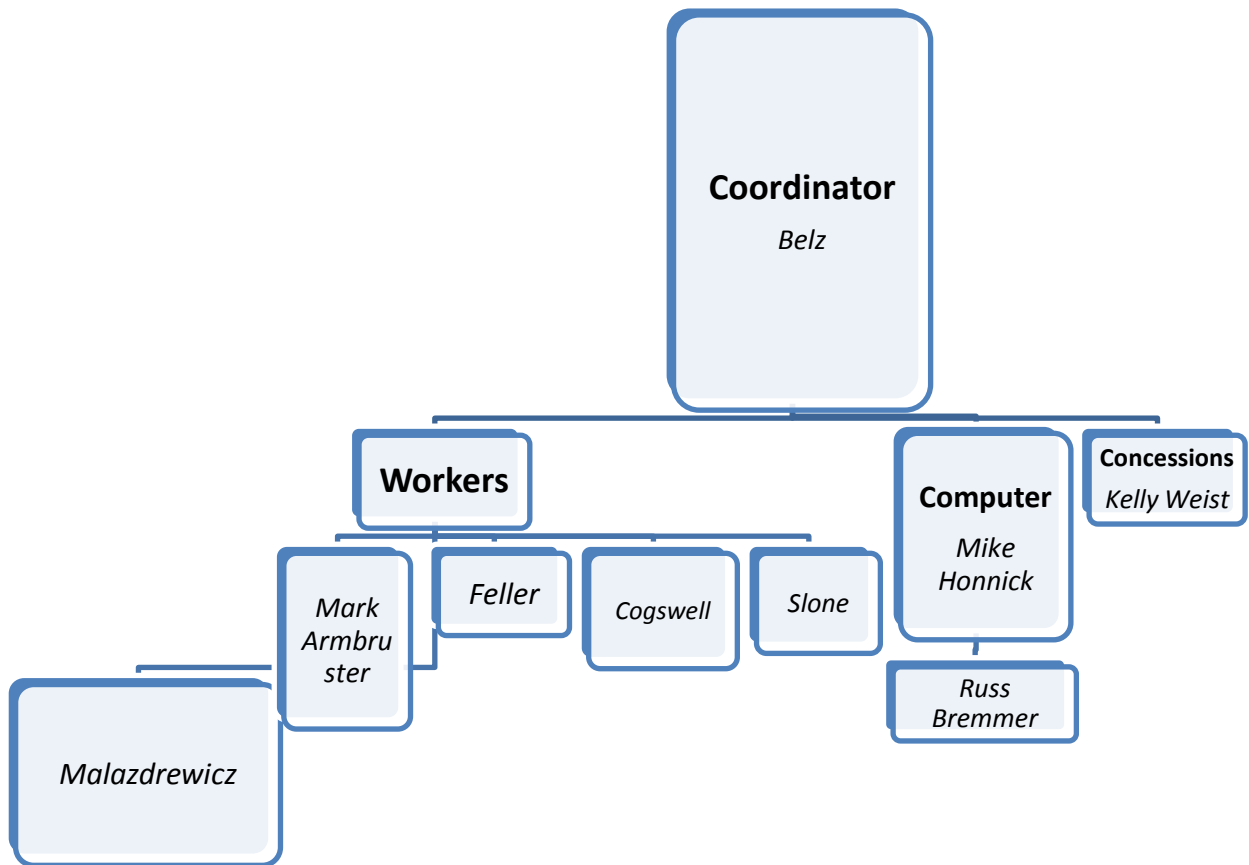


# Set Up
