



Hurricane Alert



Jeffco Hurricane September Open Saturday September 25th, 2021

- Sanction:** This is a Colorado Swimming event, hosted by the Jeffco Hurricanes Evergreen. Held under the sanction of USA Swimming # 2021-116. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming be free from any liabilities or claims or damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Facility:** George Meyers Pool, 7900 Carr Rd., Arvada, CO 80005. This Indoor 25 yard, 10-lane pool is located at an Elevation of 5300 ft. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA swimming. The depth of the pool ranges 4 feet in lane 10 at the start end and the turn end to 12 feet in lane 1 at the start end and turn end.
- Timing:** Colorado Timing System 6 with 10-lane scoreboard, shallow end Dolphin timing for 25's, and Dolphin backup timing for each lane for 50's and 100's. All events are timed finals.
- Format:** A one-day meet where each swimmer may be entered in a **maximum of 4 individual events**. No qualifying times.
- Schedule:** Saturday Session 1 - 7:30AM Warm-up, 8:10 AM Start, Session 2- **Warm-up and Start times will be determined based on number of meet entries.**
- Rules & Eligibility:** Current USA Swimming Rules & Regulations will govern meet procedures. The meet referee will be final authority. All swimmers must have current 2021 or 2022 USA Swimming registration. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of membership. The meet will be pre-seeded. Age will be determined as of September 25th, 2021.
- Per USA Swimming rule 302.4, Colorado Swimming Inc. will impose a fine of \$100 per swimmer who shows up on the post meet registration check charged to the team account. Teams will receive one Meet Recon email as a reminder to register the swimmers. As soon as the post meet registration check is run the team will be charged.
- Entries are limited to the first 300 swimmers outside of the Jeffco Swim Team for each session. No team will be split, unless they express that desire.
- Colorado Swimming warm-up procedures will be followed. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by as USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility for the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Unattached/unaccompanied swimmers will be assigned to an Evergreen team coach for warm-up/warm-down and to act in their interests for the meet, and must report to the meet referee for assignment of the coach. No exhibition swimming will be allowed.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present." Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair. No on deck photography from behind the starting platforms during starts and

relays.

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet

“No swimmer who is not a member of USA Swimming shall be allowed to complete. A meet recon prior to the meet will help identify any athlete that is not in compliance. While it is absolutely the responsibility of the athlete member to complete the requirements of membership (including APT for 18 & over athletes), as a safeguard, it is the responsibility of the LSC to ensure that all swimmers competing in a sanctioned event be members of USA Swimming in good standing.

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer’s responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

Coaches & Officials:

All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards while on deck. Current certification for all coaches is mandatory. Coaches that are not in compliance will not be allowed on deck.

Entry Fee:

\$40.00 per swimmer (\$4.20 goes to the CSI Support Fund). Fees must accompany meet entries and are non-refundable. Make one check payable to Evergreen Swim Team.

Entries:

All Meet entries should be submitted via E-mail using Hy-Tek Meet Manager software and received by the entry chair by **8:00 PM Monday 20th**. Copies of TM Individual entry report and TM Entry Fee Report must accompany entries. NT entries will be accepted but will be seeded with the slowest heats. No Deck entries and Deck Registration will be accepted. Event Drop / Add entries will be accepted (for swimmers already entered in the meet) for available lanes only, no new heats will be created.

Coaches will be E-mailed (Warm-up and Meet Start times) by Thursday September 23rd.

Scoring & Awards:

Ribbons will be given for the first 12 places in each event for 12-Under only. No individual or team scoring.

Results:

Results will be emailed to each team. Any team requiring mailed results please put a request in writing in your entry packet.

Additional Each team may be asked to provide a timer for the duration of each session. No smoking allowed on deck, in the building or any area frequented by swimmers. No glass bottles on deck or in the restrooms. A snack bar and hospitality area will be open throughout the meet.

Info: **Bleachers and other seating will be provided. Swimmers must remain in designated areas.**
